I John M^r. Arthur of the town of New Glasgow in the County of Pictou, Shipwright, being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will & Testament.

First, I give to my daughter Mary M^r. Donald the use & improvement and income of my dwelling house, land and appurtenances situated, lying, and being at said town of New Glasgow, to w^{ch}. bounded Easterly by the Inter Colonial Railway, Southerly by lands of Richard Smith, Westerly by the Fishers Grant Road, and Northerly by lands of one Joseph M^r. Harmon, to have and to hold the same to her my said daughter Mary M^r. Donald for and during the term of her natural life.

Second, I give to my daughter Isabella M^r. Arthur on the death of my said daughter Mary M^r. Donald provided she survives my said daughter Mary M^r. Donald the use, improvement and income of my said dwelling house, land and appurtenances above mentioned, and described for and during the term of her natural life, from the decease of my said daughter Mary M^r. Donald.

Third, At the decease of my said daughter Isabella M^r. Arthur, or in the event of my said daughter Mary M^r. Donald surviving said Isabella M^r. Arthur then in such case on the decease of my said daughter Mary M^r. Donald it is my will that my said dwelling house, land and appurtenances above mentioned and described shall be sold by my executor hereinafter named, to do which full power and Authority is hereby given and the proceeds from such sale I give devise and bequeath to the children if any of my son Daniel M^r. Arthur sons of or near Ratportage, share and share alike, to have and to hold

the same to them their Heirs and assigns forever.

I appoint my son James M^r Arthur of said town of New Glasgow Merchant, Executor of this my last Will and testament with full power and Authority to carry out the provisions of the same.

In testimony whereof I the said John M^r Arthur have to this my last Will and testament subscribed my name and affixed my Seal this fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Ninety four.
