I give devise and bequeath to Robert
M^r. Gunnigle my nephew, all my lands, buildings,
stock, farming implements, monies and debts
to be by him freely possessed and enjoyed for
ever. It is my will also that Hannah my
beloved sister shall have out of said estate
an abundant home during her lifetime, as also
a decent Christian burial. I exempt all others in my
connection by a Shilling Sterling. I make
Constitute and ordain Angus M^r. Tuarie and
Alexander Cuthbert and both on the borders of
Scotch Hill my executors of this my last
will and testament, and I do hereby utterly
disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every
other former testament, wills, legacies, and bequests
and executors, by me in any wise before named
willed and bequeathed, ratifying and

Confirming this and no other to be my
last Will and testament. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this eleventh day of May in the year of Our
Lord, one thousand eight hundred and
eighty six.
