

This is the last Will and Testament of one Simon
McLean of Cariboo Island County of Pictou, Farmer.

First I give devise and bequeath to my beloved
wife Elizabeth McLean, forty acres of the farm that I
now reside on to be laid off on the East side joining
the lands of Mathew Harris with the one half of the
House and Barn during her life time should she survive
me. I also devise and bequeath to my two daughters
namely Nancy McLean, & Margaret McLean the forty
acres abovenamed after the death of my beloved
wife Elizabeth McLean, with the house and buildings
now on my farm subject to my son Finley McLean
having the use of the one half of the House until
he erects one for himself on his own side of the farm.

I also give to my son Finley McLean the one half
of the stock on the farm after my death or at the time of
my death.

I give devise and bequeath to my son
Finley McLean the other side of my farm containing
fifty acres more or less. to have and to hold the same
to him and his heirs for ever.

Lastly I also give and bequeath
to my beloved wife Elizabeth McLean all the residue
of my property of whatsoever nature after my death,
and all my just debts being paid to be disposed
of as she thinks fit should she survive me.
And I nominate and appoint Alexander McLean
Kearie of Cariboo Island, and Donald Fraser
of Acadia Farm Esquire, executors of this my last
Will and testament, hereby revoking all other
and former wills.
