my last will and testament I
bequeath my soul to God and my

containing two acres of land together
with all my furniture, the feed and
pasture of two cows and four
sheep during the remainder of
her natural life. To my son
Walter I bequeath four hundred
dollars. To my daughter Nancy
deceased I bequeath fifty dollars
To my daughter Susan Mary
I bequeath twenty dollars

To my daughter Clority I bequeath
the privilege of my home while she
remains unmarried

To my son Alexander I bequeath
all my real estate and personal property
subject to the above bequests
I bequeath to Alex and Clority
(before mentioned) the remainder
of my money after all my
just debts are paid to be
divided equally between them
