*All schools (class rooms) in cities and incorporated towns shall henceforth be classed as *Urban* schools; other schools in sections with *more than one* teacher shall be classed as *Village* schools; and all other schools with *only one* teacher in which several grades are taught shall be classed as *Rural* schools. The school statistics of each county shall hereafter be exhibited under these three sub-divisions. The first blank above should be filled in with the appropriate one of these three names. The statistics must contain the information called for by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics as agreed upon by the Provinces of Canada in conference.

If the "Village" or "Rural" school is "consolidated" (that is, has pupils from a distance "conveyed" and draws also a "consolidation" grant), "Consolidated School" should be written in the space above the name of the section. Blanks should be filled in by a neatly drawn line. The "teacher" in a "rural" school is also "the principal of the schools of the section."
